

Encaustic paintings inspire Cedir Ceramiche

ITALIAN company, Cedir Ceramiche, says its porcelain Abaco range is inspired by an ancient technique of encaustic painting – the process of painting walls and surfaces using colour and liquid wax. This is then applied with brushes and broad knives, and fixed with fire.

Cedir Ceramiche says Abaco brings a certain refinement and elegance to a room, and combines both a classical and contemporary look.



The range is made from gres porcelain with a coloured body. It is available in nine colours, and would easily fit within both residential and commercial properties.

Abaco has two finishes: natural – available in 50 x 50cm format – and the waxed-rectified tile, and available in 49 x 49cm and 16.3 x 49cm.
